The Bill Wallace Trail Access Program is a partnership of California State Parks, El Capitan Canyon, Friends of Channel Coast State Park, and Land Trust for Santa Barbara County. This initiative was developed to help promote public access to the 2500-acre El Capitan Canyon backcountry.

After checking in at the Kiosk and parking, hikers meet at the El Capitan Canyon Market on Saturdays at 9:00 a.m. Hikes will last 3 to 4 hours.

- ◆ Remember that wilderness is wild. Please come prepared by bringing water, snacks, hiking shoes, a hat and sunscreen.
